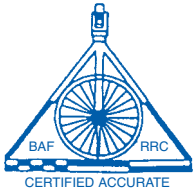

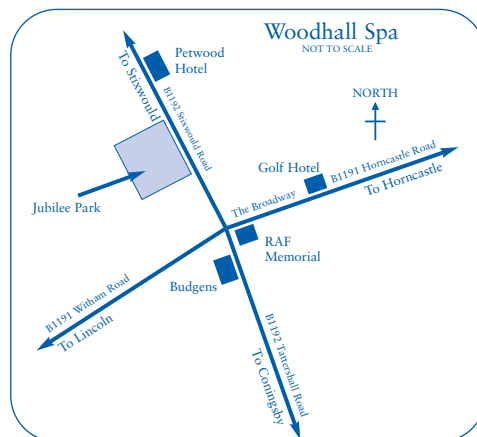

Woodhall Spa

Woodhall Spa is situated 14 miles south east of the city of Lincoln, and is easily reached by road. Woodhall is not a large town and you should have little difficulty finding Jubilee Park - the sketch map shows some of the main landmarks to help you find us. The 10K event is based in Jubilee Park (OS Grid: TF190634) with the Information Desk and Late Entry Desk based here in the Cricket Pavilion. There is also ample parking along with designated parking areas for wheelchair competitors with easy access to the course.

The Woodhall Spa 10K has established itself as one of the premier events in the region with athletes coming from across the county to compete on this flat course through the beautiful Lincolnshire countryside. The 10K Run is expected to attract some 1000 athletes, many of whom will be first time 10K competitors and of a wide age range. The event is open to both runner and wheelchair competitors. The event is organised by a team of volunteers with all profits going to local good causes; and, run to the exacting standards required by the British Association of Road Races.

For postal entries, once your entry form has been processed you will receive back detailed competitor instructions, your running number and chip. Please do not expect to receive these until late May.

The Kinema in the Woods and Kinema Too is one of the few back projection cinemas in the country and even offers entertainment on an original Compton Organ.
