It's that time of year when we think about setting off on our holidays
Help reduce the risk of your home being broken into by taking some simple home security measures.

Make sure your house look occupied. Closed curtains in the daytime makes it look as if no one is at home - ask a trusted neighbour to collect post, open and close curtains.

It is worthwhile to get automatic time switches to switch lights and a radio on and off in downstairs rooms.

Cancel deliveries of milk, newspapers etc, discreetly - don't announce your departure to a shop full of people. Only tell people who need to know you're going away.

Don't have your home address showing on your luggage for the outward journey. Put this only on the inside of your cases.

Arrange for pets to be properly looked after.

Finally, lock all outside doors and windows. If you have a burglar alarm, make sure it is set.
