**Actions:**

- LIAISE WEEKLY WITH CCTV AND LOCAL RESIDENTS
- LIAISE WITH SECTOR INSPECTOR TO BID FOR RESOURCES FOR EXTRA PATROLS
- HIGH VISIBILITY PATROLS OF THE AREA AND DETAILS OF PERSONS CHECKED TO BE PASSED TO NPT FOR

Stay safe this autumn

British Summertime ends at the end of October, which signals the start of dark nights and cold weather.

Top tips for your safety

If you're leaving your house unattended make sure you fit timer switches so that it looks occupied, draw curtains and blinds so your items are not in view of windows. Leave a radio on; this will also keep pets calm.

If you are using a bicycle or motorbike ALWAYS wear High Visibility clothing. Hi Vis waistcoats cost very little and could save your life.

Park your car in a well lit area and remove ALL valuables and SATNAV holder marks from windcreens. Look for safer car park signs; this means the car park has passed minimum standards for safety and security.

If walking, stay in well lit areas and be aware of who is around you. If you feel threatened or at risk, knock on a neighbours door or enter a public area.

Many children love to participate in trick or treating, but when this becomes an annoyance to residents, it is classed as anti-social behaviour.

Make sure your children only call at houses where they know the residents. If they see the poster below, they should not knock or call.



Bonfire night

Fireworks can be exhilarating, but when they are mishandled, they can cause devastating injuries!

ALWAYS use a torch to read instructions on fireworks and keep unused fireworks safe in a metal box.

NEVER return to an unexploded firework.

PLEASE, also remember to keep pets indoors and where possible, use TV's and radios to help detract from fireworks causing unnecessary upset

It is against the law:

For anyone under 18 years of age to buy or handle fireworks.

To throw or set fireworks off in the street. To let fireworks off between 11pm and 7am.
